Barcelona acogerá el 25º Congreso de la Asociación Europea de Urología

Con el objetivo de intercambiar y divulgar información y novedades entre los profesionales de la urología para mejorar la atención al paciente en todo el mundo, **el próximo mes de abril Barcelona acogerá el Congreso de la Asociación Europea de Urología (EAU), que este año conmemora su 25ª edición.**

Se trata de una edición especial de este encuentro anual que se prolongará, por primera vez, durante una semana: **del viernes 16 al martes 20 de abril. Cinco jornadas en las que se abordarán, entre otras, las áreas de pediatría, cáncer de vejiga, urología femenina, carcinoma de células renales, reconstrucción y urología funcional, obstrucción prostática benigna y cálculos,** entre otras.

Se espera que el 25 Congreso de la EAU atraiga a Barcelona a más de 11.000 delegados y a unos 3.000 representantes de compañías. En los últimos años se ha producido un aumento notable en el número de participantes, que ha ido paralelo al desarrollo de un programa científico de calidad. Para esta edición han sido aceptados un total de 1.089 resúmenes, incluidos 46 resúmenes en vídeo, que serán presentados en 78 sesiones de resúmenes y 8 sesiones de vídeo.

El Congreso arrancará con la rueda de prensa oficial de la EAU, que tendrá lugar el sábado 17 de abril, a las 12.00 horas, en la Sala de Conferencias de Prensa. En ella se celebrará una mesa redonda titulada Detección del cáncer de próstata en Europa: El debate continúa, que se centrará en el futuro de las políticas sanitarias europeas de detección del cáncer de próstata, tras los resultados de los estudios presentados el año pasado. El tema será debatido por los mejores expertos, como los profesores Schröder (Países Bajos) y Holmberg (Suecia), con el profesor Hamdy (Reino Unido) como moderador. El Sr. Alojz Peterle, diputado del Parlamento Europeo, hablará sobre la política actual de la UE y su visión de futuro.
